Applications not completed entirely are rejected. When submitting an application, please share photos of your home, including a front (view should include the street) and the back yard area (fenced area if applicable) and the rooms in the home the dog will have access to. This will help to give us a sense of what your environment would be like for a rescued Doberman, and help us match every dog to the appropriate home. All submitted applications are kept on a secure server not connected to the Internet and your information is confidential, "FDR" has a strict non-sharing policy.

When you have completed the application, you may email it back to FDR at info@fureverhomesdobermanrescue.org or you may snail mail it back to the address listed above.

Primary Applicant

Adults, excluding children, residing in the household must be listed as an applicant/secondary applicant, i.e. husband/wife, partners, engaged couples, etc. Adult children, age 25 years or older residing with their parents will require a parent within the household as a secondary applicant if the parent is the home owner.

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ADOPTION CRITERIA

Are you ready to adopt a rescued Doberman?

- All adults must be a minimum of 25 years of age and sign the application.
- Own your residence, and submit a letter from your H.O.A. (Home Owners Association) if you have one, along with your application. Renters and Lease agreements are considered on a case by case basis. A letter of approval from the Landlord or Management, to have a Doberman at the residence, is required.
- No more than 3 dogs currently reside in the household and the home environment is large enough to accommodate an additional large breed dog comfortably.
- All dogs must reside inside your home, all resident dogs must be neutered/spayed, up to date on vaccinations and taking a heartworm and flea/tick preventative.
- As a general rule FDR does not place Dobermans into homes with children under the age of 10, however we evaluate each application and rescued Doberman on a case by case basis.
- Your application must list all residents of the household, human and animal, in addition to any other humans or animals who will have access to the dog.
- Your application must include your current employer; we do verify you are employed to establish an applicant's ability to care for a new addition.
- You must provide a current or a previous veterinary reference if you do not currently have a pet. If you do not currently have a veterinarian, an account must be established with one in preparation for an adoption that can be verified by the application processor. Applications with no veterinary reference provided will not be processed.
- Your application must include two personal, non-family references. Applications without the requested personal references will not be processed.
- A traditional fenced in yard with the fence connected to the home is always preferred, however we evaluate each application and rescued Doberman on a case by case basis.
- Every applicant understands they will be required to complete a minimum of one obedience course with a certified positive reinforcement trainer, approved or recommended by rescue.
- Applications not completed entirely will not be processed.

GENERAL FACTS

1. An application submission does not entitle you to a dog.
2. The application process is to help us get to know you, your environment, lifestyle, experience with the breed (or comparable breed) and about the Doberman you are interested in adopting, this helps us to help you in finding an appropriate match for your home.
3. A submitted application and application check does not automatically qualify you for a home visit. Applications that do not meet our minimum criteria listed above will not qualify for a home visit.
4. All placements are required to complete a minimum two to four-week In-Home Trial prior to the completion of the Adoption, the time-frame will be determined by the rescue.
5. The Adoption fee is required the day a Doberman is placed in your home, the date the In-Home Trial begins. All adoption fees are non-refundable.
6. Applicants are welcome to apply for a specific dog they may have seen listed available for adoption, however it is the policy of FDR to match our rescued Dobermans with homes that are the best environment and lifestyle for each individual dog's personality and needs. We may not be able to consider the dog requested, and we will be happy to discuss Doberman(s) in our program we feel would be the best match for you.
7. Many applicants are interested in a puppy (under 1 year of age); it is the policy of FDR to complete adoptions for purebred Doberman puppies only with families who have breed experience. If you've never been owned by a Doberman, we will recommend an older Doberman with a well-rounded temperament as your first Doberman or a mixed breed puppy if one is currently available in the program.
8. All residents of the household including adults, children and animals must be present for the home visit.
9. The adoption application process generally takes approximately 3-4 weeks from application submission to placement of a dog. The application is checked within 5 days and if an applicant qualifies for a home visit, depending on your schedule and that of our volunteer completing the visit on our behalf, could take a few weeks to complete. An approval or denial letter is emailed to each applicant, those applicants qualifying for a home visit and approved to adopt from FDR will receive a follow up call to discuss available for adoption Dobermans currently in the program and any others who may be coming in very soon.

Fureverhomes Doberman Rescue, Inc. reserves the right to decline an application based on the information or lack of information provided by the applicant, and what is discovered during the application process, we are under no obligation to adopt a specific dog to any applicant. Placement and recommendations are made based on the applicant's environment, lifestyle and experience with the breed. FDR is proud of our adoption record and if we do not currently have an appropriate match for your household, we will retain your application for a future possibility.

2025 Adoption Fee Schedule:

- Puppies (purebred under 1 year of age) = \$600 (\$500 mix)
- Young (purebred age 1-2 years) = \$575 (\$475 mix)
- Young Adult (purebred age 3-4 years) = \$550 (\$450 mix)
- Adult (purebred age 5-6 years) = \$525 (\$425 mix)
- Pre-Senior (purebred age 7-8 years) = \$500 (\$400 mix)
- Senior purebred age 9 years and up) = \$475 (\$375 mix)
- Special Needs = case by case

***The Adoption Fee is due at the time of placement when beginning the required In-Home Trial period.**
